Recommended Activities

1. *Document any invasive weeds present on your property, including blackberry, holly, ivy, and others. Write up management recommendations for controlling these weeds, focusing on integrated pest management, which means considering multiple control options (mechanical, cultural, chemical). Include this information in the forest health/wildfire/invasive species section of your plan.
2. Consider how you would do a forest inventory on your property. How many plots would you put in? What specific things would you measure? If you choose to do an inventory, mark plot locations on your map. We'll go over measurement techniques on the field trip.
